





<p><b>Senior Commander</b> (also: responsible for Outpost calendar, calendar request sheets, &amp; van request sheets. [and turning them into children's pastor] Signing all purchase order, reimbursement, and van request sheets and forwarding to children's pastor.)</p>	<p>Coordinates activities that involve two or more age groups and Serves as liaison between the commanders and the Outpost Council. Responsible for running the Ranger ministry and as such - sets policy/procedures in line with that of the church. Presents such policy &amp; procedures to the Outpost council for approval. Implements policy &amp; procedures approved by the outpost council. Oversee training of Commanders.</p>
<p><b>Senior Staff: Kris Stewart, Robert Johnson, Dan Syrcle, &amp; Bill Brown</b></p>	<p>Support and assist Senior Commander in implementing policy and procedure established by the Senior Commander &amp; approved by the outpost council in their respective areas of responsibility. Forwarding all purchase order, reimbursement, and van request sheets and forwarding to Senior Commander for his signature.</p>
<p><b>Khaki / FCF Coordinator: Dan Syrcle</b></p> <p>[passes along information to his staff from Sr. Cdr. &amp; Council]</p>	<p>Responsible to the Senior Cdr. for assisting khaki group commanders in obtaining supplies for meetings and planning events/camps for Discover, Adventure &amp; Expedition Rangers. Assist the Sr. Cdr in the training of commanders for events/camping and orientating of the Camping Assistants for events/camping according to established policy &amp; procedures. Advancement Coordinator for Discover, Adventure &amp; Expedition Rangers. Promotes Frontier Camping Fellowship [FCF] Ministry.</p>
<p><b>Outpost Council</b></p>	<p>Help promote the Ranger Ministry in the Church. Approve or disapprove of policies set forth by Senior Commander. Help recruit and screen leaders. Help provide facilities for the Outpost. Assist in raising funds for Outpost. Assist in chartering boys/teens for the Outpost. Become familiar with Royal Ranger ministry and obtain training.</p>

<b>Equipment Coordinator – Kris Stewart</b>	<b>Maintains an inventory of the outpost’s camping equipment; provides for storage and repair of equipment. Arranges transportation, supplies, and equipment for meetings, camping trips or outings. Trains quartermasters in their duties. Assists on outings and campouts.</b>
<b>Ranger Kids Coordinator – Bill Brown</b>	<b>Responsible to the Senior Cdr. for assisting RK group commanders’ in obtaining supplies for meetings, passing along information from Sr. Cdr./council and planning day camps for Ranger Kids. Assist Sr. Cdr. in the overall training of commanders and orientation of the Camping assistants according to established policy &amp; procedures. Advancement Coordinator for Ranger Kids.</b>
<b>Supply Officer – Robert Johnson</b>	<b>Assist Equipment Coordinator with his duties. Assist training of all Quartermasters. Acts as camp cook. Assist in making campout menus and obtaining food supplies.</b>
<b>Group Commander -</b>  <b>[Very Similar to Sunday School Teacher]</b>  <b>Forward any request via their coordinator.</b> <b>Forward all purchase orders, reimbursement, and van request sheets to their respective coordinators</b>	<b>Has primary responsibility for weekly meetings and extra activities for given group of boys or young men and should:</b> <b>Be 21 years of age or older</b> <b>Be a born-again Christian, well-grounded in the Word of God</b> <b>Be loyal to the church</b> <b>Have habits and morals that are above reproach</b> <b>Enjoy working with boys/young men</b> <b>Have a consistent testimony in daily Christian living</b> <b>Be able to follow, lead and delegate authority</b> <b>Possess good judgment</b> <b>Be willing to accept responsibility</b> <b>Command the respect of others</b> <b>Cooperate with the programs of the church &amp; Outpost policy &amp; procedures</b> <b>Be willing to take leadership training</b>

<p><b>Lt. Commander –</b></p> <p>Forward any request via Group Commander. Forward all purchase orders, reimbursement, and van request sheets to their respective Group Commanders.</p>	<p>The role of the lieutenant commander is to assist the commander. (Lieutenant commanders must be 18 or Older)  Other than age requirement, their requirements are exactly the same as for a group commander  Some duties are:  Assist with one or more parts of the meeting; Help counsel the boys  Help with discipline in the meeting; Assist in signing off requirements for advancements; &amp; Take over for the commander in his absence</p>
<p><b>Camp Assistants –</b> <b>Moms, Dads, Men, &amp; Women</b></p>	<p>Dads and other men in Men’s ministry – who are willing to go on one to two campouts a year. This will involve going to council fire services with boys, making hot chocolate at night, and assist with games. The outpost usually has 5 overnight campouts a year and two day camps a year. Camp assistants are a “ Major” blessing to the Commanders and an inspiration to the boys.</p>
<p><b>Greeters</b></p>	<p>Two Dads and other men in Men’s ministry – who come down on Wednesday nights to greet new boys and present the plan of salvation to them. This should take no more than 15-20 minutes and then the greeters can return to service.</p>
<p><b>Special guest –</b></p>	<p>Dads and other men in Men’s ministry who wish to teach a skill or share information/knowledge with a group of boys.</p>

<b>Chaplain – Pastor Tim Bryant</b>	<b>Is the overall director of kids ministry departments and serves as Outpost Chaplain. Junior Chaplain is a liaison between the boys/teens &amp; the Chaplain/ Sr. Cdr.</b>
<b>Senior Advisor – Chris Austin</b>	<b>Mentors, gives directional guidance and is the accountability partner for the Senior Commander. Chairs Outpost Council meetings.</b>
<b>Senior Commander – Stan Lewis</b>	<b>Coordinates all Council activities. Develop policies and procedures for the local outpost consistent with the Oaks Fellowship, N. Tx. District, &amp; National policies and procedures [which are approved by the outpost council.] Implements such polices. Selects teens to serve as Prideland Scribe, Junior Chaplain, FCF Scout, and Quartermaster. Conducts formal council of achievements &amp; GMA ceremonies with assistance of MC Coordinator.</b>
<b>Equipment Coordinator – Kris Stewart</b>	<b>Maintains an inventory of the outpost’s camping equipment; provides for storage and repair of equipment; arranges transportation, supplies, and equipment for camping trips or outings; and assists on outings and campouts.</b>
<b>Pinewood Derby Coordinator Rick Pena</b>	<b>Helps promote Pinewood derby and related activities</b>
<b>MC Coordinator Don Hanna</b>	<b>Makes sure every Ranger receives immediate recognition for advancements, helps Khaki and Ranger Kids coordinators plan and conduct informal Councils of Achievement, and assists commanders as needed in encouraging Rangers to earn more merits &amp; advancements. Assist Sr. Cdr. with formal Councils of Achievement.</b>
<b>Publicity Coordinator - Richard Lynch</b>	<b>Publicizes activities of the outpost, utilizing internet, Outpost Blog site, newspapers, letters, bulletins, newsletters, etc. <u>Sherry Del Valle</u> will act as his assistant. She will do the newsletters and forward them to Cdr. Lynch to publish on our Blog site.</b>
<b>Ranger Kid Coord. – Bill Brown</b>	<b>In addition to his duties as RK Coordinator, he serves as a Councilman</b>
